

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK HILL
SUPPORTING THE CITY OF ROCK HILL'S APPLICATION FOR STATE MASS
TRANSIT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012

WHEREAS, the City of Rock Hill recognized as a small urban area, is authorized to apply for state funds under the State Mass Transit Funds (SMTF) program;

WHEREAS, the City of Rock Hill will be requesting funds to match federal program dollars to support the 82X & 78X bus routes and York County Access essential services and the peak period (ride-to-work) program, as well as transit service and planning studies for the urban area;

WHEREAS, the City of Rock Hill agrees to comply with all Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and/or State program requirements as administered by the South Carolina Department of Transportation to include the local match requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council agrees to support the City of Rock Hill's application for State Mass Transit Funds in the amount of **\$157,315** for Fiscal Year 2011-2012.
