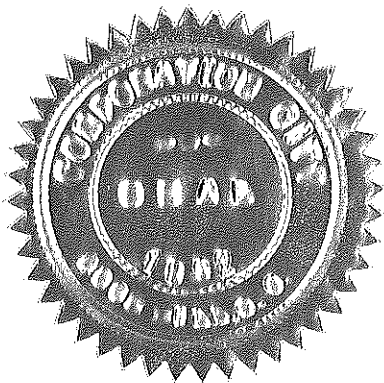
- WHEREAS,** since its inception in 1985, the Rotary International PolioPlus program has helped more than 2 billion children throughout the world receive oral polio vaccines; and

- WHEREAS,** thousands of Rotarians in Rock Hill have committed to doing their part to help eradicate the polio virus from the world;


