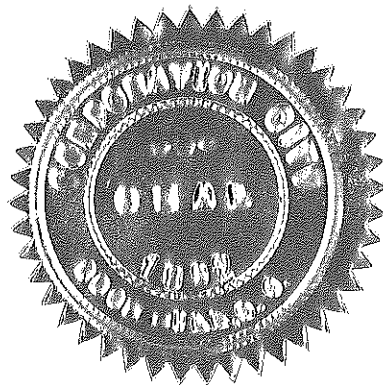
WHEREAS, the men and women of Rock Hill Public Safety unceasingly provide a vital public service; and
