This agreement is being entered into pursuant to the authority provided in S.C. Code Ann. §23-1-210 (2007) as amended, between the Sheriff of York County, the County of York and the participating municipalities of the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit (YCMDEU) and/or the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team (YCMHIT). This agreement is not made pursuant to the Law Enforcement Assistance and Support Act as provided for in S.C. Code Ann. §23-20-10 et.seq, and is not governed by that Act.

1. The participating agencies in the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit and/or the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team (YCMHIT) are the Clover Police Department [CPD], the Fort Mill Police Department [FMPD], the Rock Hill Police Department [RHDP], the Tega Cay Police Department [TCPD], Winthrop Public Safety [WPS], the York Police Department [YPD], the York County Sheriff's Office [YCSO] and the Office of the 16th Judicial Circuit Solicitor [Solicitor]. The York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit (YCMDEU) and the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team (YCMHIT) will be governed by the chief executive officer of each participating agency (Governing Board). The YCMDEU will operate according to the Memorandum of Understanding, operational policies, procedures, rules, and regulations as adopted by the Governing Board.
2. It is agreed that each participating municipal agency shall assign officer(s) to the York County Sheriff's Office, on a temporary basis, for assignment to the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit and/or the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team. While assigned to the YCMDEU and/or YCMHIT, the officers so transferred shall be vested with equal authority and jurisdiction as any other regularly commissioned officer of the York County Sheriff's Office.
3. The York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit and the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team have the following responsibilities:
 - 3.1 To disrupt the illicit drug traffic in the State of South Carolina, the York County area, and adjacent regions, to include adjoining states;
 - 3.2 To gather and compile intelligence data relating to trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs;

- 3.3 To conduct undercover operations when appropriate and engage in other traditional methods of investigation in order to effectively prosecute drug law violations in the courts with appropriate jurisdiction;
 - 3.4 To cooperate with state and federal law enforcement agencies in the investigation, arrest, and prosecution of upper level drug dealers;
 - 3.5 To enforce the law related to money laundering and organized crime activities;
 - 3.6 To target and enforce vice related crimes, such as gambling, solicitation/prostitution, alcohol related crimes; such as, underage drinking;
 - 3.7 To enforce all state laws anywhere in York County. To enforce all county ordinances in any unincorporated portion of York County. To enforce any municipal ordinance of any municipality in York County while the officer is located in that municipality; and
 - 3.8 To conduct any other law enforcement investigation or activity as authorized by the YCMDEU/YCMHIT commanders and the YCMDEU/YCMHIT Governing Board.
4. The bond for any officer transferred or assigned shall include coverage for his/her activity while transferred to the York County Sheriff's Office and assigned to the YCMDEU and/or YCMHIT in the same manner and to the same extent provided by bonds of regularly employed officers of York County Sheriff's Office.
 5. The temporary transfer of officer(s) pursuant to this agreement shall in no manner affect or reduce the compensation, pension, or retirement rights of the transferred officer(s) and such transferred officer(s) shall continue to be paid by the municipality where they are permanently employed.
 6. The parties to this agreement hereby expressly agree that reimbursement for services as described in this agreement shall be limited to the reciprocal providing of services of like kind and quantity between the agencies involved. Any other agreement for reimbursement must be made in writing between the agencies on a case by case basis.
 7. The parties to this agreement acknowledge, understand and agree:
 - 7.1 York County is made a party to this agreement for the sole purpose of satisfying statutory requirements;
 - 7.2 York County does not have or exercise jurisdiction, supervision, administration, participation, control or involvement in or over the operations of the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit, or the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team, or over

York County deputy sheriffs or municipal police officers, whether permanent or temporary, involved or participating in the operations or activities of the YCMDEU and/or YCMHIT;

- 7.3 Each participant in the YCMDEU and/or the YCMHIT shall remain and be deemed an employee of the participating agency by whom he or she is employed for all purposes and each participant will sign a document acknowledging his/her employment status, a copy of which shall be maintained by the commander of the YCMDEU;
- 7.4 York County, the York County Council, and York County officials and employees have no duty, liability or responsibility for the acts or omissions, including alleged constitutional violations of any participant or member of the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Enforcement Unit and/or the York County Multi-Jurisdictional Highway Interdiction Team;
- 7.5 Subject to any and all applicable legal defenses, each participating agency shall be liable for the acts of their respective employees.
- 7.6 The approval of this agreement is subject in all respects to the terms, conditions, limitations and exceptions stated in this agreement.
8. This agreement shall remain in effect unless rescinded by any party upon written notice to the other parties.
9. This agreement shall supersede, govern and control over any prior YCMDEU agreements executed by the parties.
